### Increase your gaming floor efficiency with CARD IT.

CARD IT is at the forefront of card-based technology, providing both your player and your venue with a fast and reliable solution to managing cash.

Players can redeem money from their CARD IT account at any other compatible EGM by inserting their card, entering their PIN (if applicable) and selecting the transfer value.

When players have finished their gaming session and wish to collect their money, they can present their card at either the EGM, credit redemption terminal (CRT) or cashier station.

Alternatively, the player can leave the money on their card until their next visit at your venue (maximum of 12 months without card use).

Players can load money onto their card in two simple ways;

#### 1. At the EGM

• Players insert cash into a gaming machine and begin to play. When the player is ready to collect, they simply remove their card from the Pathway unit. The credit is then transferred to the player's card.

#### 2. At the cashier station

• Players can present their card at the cashier for money to be loaded onto their card.



### For members who have activated CARD IT, they have access to the following;

- Use existing members card for CARD IT.
- Transfer \$1,000 or less into an EGM. Provided that the transfer does not cause the accumulated credits standing on the machine to exceed \$1000.
- Transfer up to \$1,999.99 out of an EGM.
- Receive CRT payouts with a card balance to the value of \$1,999.99.
- Earn loyalty points.

### For non registered CARD IT players, they can access the following;

- Transfer \$1,000 or less into and out of an EGM.
- Transfer up to \$1,999.99 out of an EGM.
- Receive CRT payouts to the value of \$1,999.99.
- The card remains valid for the player to use at either an EGM or CRT from 6 months to 12 months (which the venue has the ability to set the time frame for this period).
- No personal details are linked to the card, and the player will not accrue loyalty points.
- Option for PIN to be set by player.
