MyTicket provides both players and venues with a reliable way to manage cash in a gaming room.

Available in Queensland and Northern Territory.

MyTicket is a gaming solution that enables venue players to transfer credit from gaming machine to gaming machine using secure, bar-coded tickets.

Venues with the MyTicket solution allows players to insert cash into a gaming machine and begin to play. When the player is finished, they press COLLECT and a barcoded ticket is printed with the collected payout amount. This ticket can then either;

- Be inserted into another MyTicket enabled gaming machine via the bill acceptor.
- Redeemed for cash at a cash redemption terminal (CRT) or cashier station.

The MyTicket solution provides a range of potential benefits to both venues and players, including;



Increased gaming floor efficiency – decreasing the number of hand-pays and hopper refills, resulting in longer periods of gaming machine operation.



Increased staff efficiency
– manual processes such
as hand pays are reduced,
freeing up floor staff.



Increased level of customer service – reduced time at cashier stations and easy transition from one gaming machine to another.



Reduction in the amount of cash handling required, reducing the potential for errors.



Increased security – cash on-site to be secured within CRTs.



Detailed usage information reporting to better understand player behaviours.





MyTicket process is simple.



MyTicket provides a range of potential features to both venues and players, including;

- Players in Queensland can insert tickets up to the value of \$199.99 into an EGM. Northern Territory players can insert tickets up to \$1,000.
- In Queensland, tickets up to the value of \$5,000 can be collected by a player from an EGM (maximum value configured by the venue). In Northern Territory tickets up to the value of \$1,000 can be collected by a player from an EGM (maximum value configured by the venue).
- Players can receive payment via CRT to the value of the venue's maximum cash payout limit. However, venues have the option to set a collection limit below this. Payouts above the venue's cash payout limit will create a cancelled credit voucher.
- Tickets remain valid for the player to use at either an EGM or CRT or at the cashier for up to 12 months.
